PROJECT OVERVIEW

MNS oversaw the construction of a new gas station and minimart on Vandenberg. New fuel tanks were placed to service this 12 pump/24 dispenser station. A 9,000 square foot canopy covers this station.

MNS also constructed a 4,000 square foot minimart that also houses a car care center. High ground water was located in the area and MNS worked closely with the contractor to offset what could have been a costly

problem. This project was completed on time and within budget.

The 24-pump gas station built on Vandenberg AFB and opened in January 2008 is the largest in-ground gas station fuel system in Santa Barbara County. It also features the most state-of-the-art fuel monitoring system for AAFES.
